



Message

Dear Parents and CKC Students,







Do not be afraid to draw near to him, to cross the threshold of his dwelling, to speak with him, face to face, as you talk with a friend (cf. Ex 33:11). Do not be afraid of the "new life" He is offering. He himself makes it possible for you to receive that life and practise it, with the help of His grace and the gift of His Spirit



A Christian is called to be 'salt of the earth and light to the world'. Today we have lost the saltiness and our light is not burning bright anymore. Christianity taught forgiveness, peace and love to the world. Missionaries went around the world to spread peace and love. They cared for others. They loved others. Today there are no missionaries, vocations have come down and young people are not coming forward to do God's work. The Christian youth are facing a lot of challenges in a world which is increasingly becoming sceptical about anything related to God. There is also the pressure to conform to fit in a group. Pre youth, youth, and early adulthood years is the period when we strongly crave affirmation from our peers. **The problem for the Christian youth is that of conforming means abandoning Christian values in part or wholly.** A sense of being untrue to our values may later bring regret or shame, which is detrimental to emotional wellbeing. At this critical time, therefore, it is important for Christian youth to look for guidance to avoid problems later.

Today there is a fear of being accepted in a group. To avoid this fear we ask questions. For example, if all our peers are having intimate relationships, why not me? Why not smoke? Why should I go to church when everybody else seems to be having fun somewhere else?-and so many other questions. When we conform to these, we lose our own identity and even become slaves to these evils. Asking these questions is the initial step in overcoming challenges. The second step, which is the most important, is looking for the right answers from a Christian perspective.

One way of growing in faith and reinforce defense against harmful peer pressure is becoming a member of a Bible study group, you can study in a group. The Bible itself contains answers to the problems that youth face. Studying the Bible in a group is a useful way not only on learning the word as written, but also offers a forum where Christians can openly discuss the challenges they face daily, how they overcome them, or how one can overcome them in reference to Bible teachings.

Lastly, it is very important to keep the right company. Writing to Corinthians, St Paul said that ""Bad Company corrupts good character."Therefore it is important to choose good friends, good company, good job and a good partner which in turn will help us to have a good life.

I congratulate Christ the King College on celebrating its 78 years of establishment and your service to young people and for bringing our the magazine 'CROWN' on this occasion.

COLLEGE BADGE

Our Identity, Our Hallmark



The modern badge owes its origin to the days of Templars. The knights used to cover themselves with armour from head to foot and it was not so easy to identify them. To reveal their identity they used to carry their coat of arms—symbols by which they were recognized—conspicuously displayed on their shields. Hence the badge is in the form of a shield and it also meant to identify the school as if it were its personal name.

Looking at our school badge we see **three divisions**, each representing an object. In the upper division there is a crown on a **white background**—**white is a color of purity, honesty and sincerity**. The crown signifies the reward with which every student will be crowned after years of effort and labour studying and learning.

On the right side there is a lighted torch in front of an open book on a **blue ground**—**Blue is a color of the sky, the symbol of high idealism**. As everybody knows, the book is the symbol of knowledge and learning and the torch shows that the knowledge is alive. This continually reminds the student of his sacred duty to study, to learn and to increase his knowledge, which may be a source of enlightenment and inspiration to others.

On the left side, there is a Cross of the Knights of Malta on **the red and white flag of the Island of Malta**. This shows that the Christ the King College was founded by Maltese Fathers.

Under the badge there is a scroll containing a Latin inscription— the motto of our school— **CORONA NON SINE LABORE** meaning **THERE IS NO CROWN WITHOUT LABOUR**.

Cristiano Ronaldo dos **Santos Aveiro** was born on February 5th 1985 in Sao Pedro, Funchal, on the island of **Madeira, Portugal**. He is the youngest child of Maria Dolores dos Santos Aveiro and Jose Dinis Aveiro. He has a brother Hugo and two sisters Elma and Lilanca. Ronaldo took birth in a poor family. He lived in a Tin house. His father was a gardener and his mother, a cook.

After his father's death in 2005, he moved to Real Madrid. Ronaldo is currently playing for the Portugal National Team and Juventus F.C.



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
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
